

Burghwallis Diva impresses at the Great Yorkshire Show



Burghwallis Diva the two year old heifer bred and exhibited by W & M Seels from Burgh Wallis near Doncaster impressed judge Geoffrey Rodgers who runs the Hillhead herd from Dromara, Northern Ireland with his father Martin so much so that he put her up as Blonde Breed Champion at the Great Yorkshire show held in Harrogate.

Born August 2008 sired by Maidenlands Vince, Burghwallis Diva lifted both the Rebecca Seels Memorial Trophy which had been offered by her family for the Champion Female and the Perpetual Trophy for Champion Blonde animal. Messers W & M Seels then went on to win the teams of three.

Reserve Champion went to senior cow with calf at foot Hackleton Vixen bred and exhibited by Hackleton farms from Hackleton, Northampton born May 2004 daughter to Brownhill Oswald.

Vixens stable mate Hackleton Ellie born September 2009 sired by Whistley Dollar won the Junior Championship and also won the pairs class with Hackleton Elecia who was up against her in the heifer class. Elecia was also born September 2009 again sired by Whistley Dollar.

Kissthorpe Fancypants born January 2010 sired by Criffel Braveheart bred and exhibited by C Fawcett from Sand Hutton near York won the maiden heifer class.

Stubbswalden Endeavour born September 2009 sired by Stubbswalden Vangogh from Ken Jacksons herd near Doncaster won the class of bulls.
