Darius, bred and exhibited by R Davies from Lampeter born August 2008 was sired by Welsh breed champion 2010 Fronfedw Vergil. Mr R Davies was delighted to pick up both the ABP challenge shield for the senior bull class, Male championship and the Perpetual Challenge Trophy for the breed champion all presented by the judge Mr E W Quick from Crediton, Devon.



The Junior bull class and Midlands Mart Trophy was awarded to Cosdon Faroh, bred and exhibited by P Holman and P Williams from Oakehampton, Devon. Faroh born January 2010 son of Hillhead Umar will go forward to represent the breed in the junior interbreed class.

Doncombe Celine bred and exhibited by David Knight from the Doncombe herd, Bristol born November 07 and sired by French bull Nielsen won the cow class leading the way for her stable mate Doncombe Dreamtime to join her in the honours.

Doncombe Dreamtime born August 08 sired by another French bull Passo, won the senior heifer class being awarded the MC Davies Perpetual challenge trophy and the Female Championship leading to her receiving the Romer Gabriella Challenge Cup.

The intermediate heifer Kinaston Emina born May 09 bred and exhibited by R Kinnish of the Kinaston herd from Aston Botterell, Shropshire fought off strong competition in her class.
