

Bill & Ilona Thompson are having a dispersal sale of all their prize winning cows and in calf heifers on 26th October 2010 at Thainstone Agricultural Centre, Inverurie, Aberdeenshire.

Being twice winner of the National Herd competition, there will be 70 cows 64 of which have had 1 - 3 calves so are young and 70 in calf heifers, all the 140 are either lim x b.blue or b.blue x lim and quite a few homebred blondes out of blues or lims, and all are in calf to Garngour Value sire of many show calves including Smithfield baby beef champion, or a homebred son of his Fabian Cracker.



This sale will include our pedigree females which are show quality and would be suitable for pedigree breeders.



The cows will be sold in calf due to calve the end of January onwards, and we will be keeping all of the calves through the winter and selling them in the spring, unless someone one wants one to show and then we will sell them privately.



We have decided to sell them all as Bill has had both of his hips replaced and the first one he had done is going again so its time to scale back a bit, we are planning to keep around 70-80 heifers each year and put them to the bull at 2 years old in April and sell them in calf in October each year so will still be using blonde bulls.
