Semen Offer! If you are looking to take semen from a stock bull or a young bull there is an opportunity to sell a large number of straws to Genus or possibly another semen company. Many of the bulls in semen brochures are no longer owned by the semen company but merely by a semen deal with the owner. If you are considering taking straws this can offset many of the upfront costs. Some semen can often be retained or a Royalty scheme put in place.
